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#### PROJECT BRIEF




This year, Narrative Environments once again collaborated, helping plan, prepare, and put on Farm to Fork to Fuel: Davis Bike Scavenger Hunt.


Farm to Fork to Fuel was an exciting event, taking participants all around the city of Davis to explore how the Farm to Fork movement has impacted their community.

Eventually we landed on the idea to incorporate biking and energy into Farm to Fork to create Farm to Fork to Fuel.




We created this scavenger hunt thinking of families, bike lovers, and college students.


We ended up getting only families and bike lovers. Seven groups competed with 22 participants in all.






This Institute for Wine and Food Science consists of a state-of-the-art academic complex and a LEED Platinum certified winery, brewery and food and milk processing laboratory. The Institute is the only facility of its kind in the world. Just a hint: Your prize will be waiting in the gardens.

Robert Mondavi Institute for Food and Wine

This full-service grocery store showcases natural, organic and local foods and strives to offer a full spectrum of groceries and activities to serve our entire community. Find your prize inside!

Davis Food Co-op

This downtown shop is both a restaurant and a market. Their food is made with locally grown Farmer's Kitchen and organic fruits and vegetables, free range meats and sustainable fish. Their food is prepared "plat Cafe du jour". It offers delicious, homemade bioregional foods, free of gluten and casein. Have you heard about Fruit and Veggie Up? Find out about it and meet in the MU where the food is Fruit and Veggie Up distributed. There are three on-campus housing co-ops at UC Davis. Find the co-op with Agrarian in its name. In 1966 a group of students who wanted to create affordable housing options and a new student living On Campus Co-op experience at UC Davis, as an alternative to the dorms or typical apartment lifestyle. Your prize will be located through the organic garden and next to the solar panels. This is the largest planned "zero net energy" community in the United States. In 2016, this project helped secure UC Davis as the greenest university in the world as declared by GreenMetric from the Village Homes University of Indonesia. Find your prize at the bike rack by 1545B Jade St. Walker-Smith and Garzon created a fun new art installation that can charge your phone when you visit. It was created using an old gas pump, solar panels, and much love. Come to the plaza where Solar Filling Station this Solar Filling Station lives. This lab sells meat. A lot of it. They get their fresh supply from the UC Davis livestock. Meet behind the UC Davis Meat Lab building. This bike and adventure shop has been a staple of the Davis community since 1988. It was voted #1 Ken's Bike-Ski-Bike Shop in Yolo County for nine years. They also sell fun winter supplies and provide bike repair Board services.

This shop provides personalized service to customers who need help choosing a new bike, helmet, or bell. If you take your bike in to be fixed, they will provide a bike for you to use until yours is done. They sponsor the local bike club. Milo the cat hangs out in the store to keep employees company.






## SILK SCREENING
