
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**PROJECT DESCRIPTION** 

#### **GOLDEN HOUR**

For the signage system, the main source of inspiration is Californian nature and its golden light. From refreshing coastal beaches, to beautiful redwood forests, to hot open deserts, California represents a diverse ecosystem that thrives on sunshine. For the building branding, the emphasis is put on the abundant amount of sunshine as it is well known for being the golden state. In choosing the colors, the goal was to emulate the "golden hour" as well as the reoccuring color of orange, frequently found in nature. Orange works well with the existing colors and materials in California Hall while moving away from the typical blue and gold systems seen in other buildings on campus. An important motif used in the branding is wood as a material, but also as an image of tree rings. Maple is a stand-out material used in the existing architecture, so a lot of the sign types will be incorporating either a maple backing or a maple inkjet print on the side of the signs. For the typeface, URW DIN Semi Condensed, Demi was chosen because of its simplicity, legibility, and ability to allow viewers to focus on the content.





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#### VINYL




Vinyl will be used mainly fordecorative purposes, like the mural featuring the different tree rings.






#### **REGULATORY/CONTENT**

The restroom identification signage demonstrates the simplistic and minimal aesthetic of The Golden Hour branding using a bright orange acrylic sheet with maple wood trimming on the side to add dimension and depth.

#### ORIENTATION

The orientation sign is of California Lecture Hall displaying major points in the building. It is a simple and easy to read sign that is located just outside of the lecture hall corridoor that is visible once you enter the main doors of the building.





#### DIRECTIONAL

The directional sign is located on the east lobby wall above the study desks. It is meant to direct people who are entering from the far side of the building.

#### PROMOTIONAL

These promotional signs located along California Avenue display the tree rings that are found in the hallways of the building. The use of the orange and tree visuals as well as the dimensional lettering tie together interior and exterior concepts.

#### HONORARY

This honorary sign is located in the courtyard of the Hall. The orange tree ring calls back to the tree motifs throughout the entire identity.

#### IDENTIFICATION

The identification sign is the largest of the sign systems and is located at the top of the front enterance. It's meant to be large in scale so it is legible from far away. It is made of painted aluminum sheets.



#### INTERPRETIVE

This mural is meant to go on the long and empty hallway near the study lounge. It celebrates the trees native to California, as well as showing how old they can get by creating a timeline.
