WAYFINDING AND SIGNAGE SYSTEM FOR CALIFORNIA HALL

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

For the signage system, the main source of inspiration is Californian nature and its golden light. From refreshing coastal beaches, to beautiful redwood forests, to hot open deserts, California represents a diverse ecosystem that thrives on sunshine. For the building branding, the emphasis is put on the abundant amount of sunshine as it is well known for being the golden state. In choosing our colors we wanted to emulate the "golden hour" as well as the reoccuring color of orange, frequently found in nature. Orange works well with the existing colors and materials in California Hall while moving away from the typical blue and gold systems seen in other buildings on campus. An important motif used in the branding is wood as a material, but also as an image of tree rings. Maple is a stand-out material used in the existing architecture, so a lot of the sign types will be incorporating either a maple backing or a maple inkjet print on the side of the signs. For the typeface, URW DIN Semi Condensed, Demi was chosen because of its simplicity, legibility, and ability to allow viewers to focus on the content.
