



Proposal/Project Summary

- The Bauhaus taught students using a Circular Curriculum intended to get students to rethink design and better understand the relationships between the arts
- Students worked with specific materials to better understand the sensation of touch and texture, and how these impact an individual's experience with an object
- Materials in the Bauhaus curriculum include wood, glass, color, clay, metal and textiles
- This curriculum has and continues to influence the way that design schools teach students today, and emphasizes the importance of material in design
- The Baustuhls Material Chair Project chairs are designed to engage the viewer in design thinking like the Bauhaus students
- This project challenges viewers to think more about the materials that things are made of, and why these materials have been chosen
- Create conversation between the sense of touch and vision
- Questions on the chair cushions get visitors to think about the chosen material for that chair, and places the chairs in the context of the Isokon gallery and the Bauhaus
- Different experiences with each chair: one may be smooth, one may be squishy, one may be hot to the touch, etc.
- Visitors are encouraged to find other chairs in the collection throughout Green Park
- Ask visitors to leave comments about their experience through QR code to website
- Creative hashtag for collective group of photos and promotion of the collection and Bauhaus
- Chairs placed among popular spots for families and tourists
- Chair design from the Isokon collection, encouraging viewers to visit the gallery and discover more about Bauhaus and the influence in London

- They will likely recognize the style and be interested in the installation


Site Analysis

Train Stops Near Green Park




- Train Station leads

- Encourage people to find more




